Azalea 'Weston's Lollipop' [ht-125cm spr-150cm] Zones 5-9 ○ ■ Blooms are pink, light pink with a yellow flare. Fall foliage is red to orange. Slow growing, blooms in early summer, prefers moist acid soil.

Azalea 'Weston's Popsicle'

[ht-125cm spr-150cm] Zones 5-9 OD Orange pink flowers blooming in June, green shiny foliage turns burgundy in the fall, needs partial sun, well drained soil.

RHODODENDRON

Rhododendrons have long been mainstays of late spring because of their spectacular clusters of showy blooms and large green leaves that often last through winter. With thousands of varieties, there are rhododendrons for just about every landscape situation. There are low-growing Rhododendrons as well as plants that can grow up to 25 feet tall. Though most plants flower in the spring, there are also summerblooming varieties that add color and charm to the garden.
