They like their roots in shade and flowers in the sun, plant in very rich well drained soil with roots protected with mulch. Provide support such as a fence, arbor or trellis etc.

Hardy selection of the English Ivy, attractive green leaves with white veins.

GRASSES

Acorus calamus 'Variegatus'

Variegated Sweet Flag

[ht-1m] Zones 4-9 ○▷

Long wide leaves, striking bright green with creamy yellow margins. Excellent for bogs and pond edges.

Andropogon gerardii

Big Blue Stem

[ht-2m] Zones 4-9 ○▷

Native to the prairies, this grass makes an excellent tall screen. Foliage is fine to medium green and slow spreading.

Bouteloua gracilis

Blue Gramma, Mosquito Grass

[ht-40cm] Zones 3-9 ○

Native, low growing, low maintenance grass with blue-green blades and extremely decorative seed heads.

Erect, narrow clumping form. Flowers June to October, will tolerate moist soils.

Variegated with pink plumes in early summer.

Pendulous creamy-yellow blades with green vertical lines.

Low growing sedge, likes sun or shade, good for massing.

Ice Dance Sedge

This Japanese selection forms a low, tufted mound of dark green grassy leaves, each edged in bright white. Useful as a groundcover or edging plant in the shade.

This Sedge has narrow, white-edged leaves that provide a fine texture to break up more dense areas in the garden. It grows to 12" in part to full shade. It is great for the front of the border, in drifts, or just tucked in here and there.

Bronze Veil Tufted Hair Grass

[ht-1m] Zones ○▶

Plants form a low mound of dark-green leaves, bearing upright stems with clouds of tiny, airy flowers in a bronzy-green shade, maturing to beige. Light and billowing in effect, a wonderful contrast to bold-leaved plants

Golden Pendant Tufted Hair Grass

[ht-1m] Zones 4-9 ○▶

Clump-forming tufted grass. Produces masses of frothy, golden yellow flowers in mid-summer. Creates a beautiful mist-like shimmer effect. Easy to grow in sun to partial shade. Will tolerate shadier areas.

Coarse green foliage, upright open form, will grow up to 6' with silvery-white plumes.

Elijah Blue Fescue Grass

[ht-30cm] Zones 5-9 ○

Dwarf, clump forming, silvery-blue foliage.

Hakonechloa macra 'Aureola'

Variegated Japanese Forest Grass

[ht-50cm] Zones 5-9 ●

Loose weeping, cascading mounds of golden variegated foliage, reddish-pink in the fall. 2009 Perennial of the year.

Golden Japanese Forest Grass

Slow growing, gold-yellow foliage, blooms late summer to early fall.

Stiff silvery blue leaves to 30 cm or more, erect panicles of straw coloured spikes in summer.

Japanese Blood Grass

[ht-80cm] Zones 6-9 ○▶

Green upright foliage that turns purple red from tips downward.

Unicorn Rush

[ht-80cm] Zone 6 ○

Deep green, spiralling tubular stems.

Liriope muscari ‘Big Blue’*Big Blue Lily Turf***[ht-45cm] Zones 5-9** ○▶

This lilyturf cultivar is a tufted, grass-like perennial which features a clump of strap-like, arching, glossy, dark green leaves. Erect, showy lavender blue flowers rise just above the leaves in late summer. Flowers give way in fall to blackish berries which often persist into winter.

Low clump of grass-like evergreen leaves with white flower.

Miscanthus sinensis ‘Adagio’*Adagio Maiden Grass***[ht-1.5m] Zones 5-9** ○▶

Pink inflorescence blooms appear in August turning to white with maturity, thin silvery-grey foliage.

Finely textured grey-green foliage forms a dense upright vase shaped clump, plumes are reddish-pink maturing to beige.

Compact, upright growing habit, unique horizontal gold bar stripe. The stripe starts from the base and continues to the top of plant.

Miscanthus sinensis**‘Huron Sunrise’***Huron Sunrise Maiden Grass***[ht-1.5m] Zones 5-9** ○▶

Foliage is green with silver midrib, profuse burgundy blooms in late summer.

Miscanthus sinensis**‘Little Kitten’***Dwarf Maiden Grass***[ht-60cm] Zones 5-9** ○▶

Silvery green foliage, silvery white pink tinged blooms in late summer.

Miscanthus sinensis**‘Morning Light’***Variegated Maiden Grass***[ht-1.5m] Zones 5-9** ○▶

Forms a dense non-invasive clump if in sun or light shade, foliage is creamy white with green midrib, bronze to cream blooms in early fall.

Green foliage, turning reddish in the late summer, white plumes in late summer.

Has fine grey-green foliage, burgundy plumes in late summer, similar to Gracillimus but shorter in height.

Miscanthus sinensis 'Silberfeder'

Silver Feather Grass

[ht-2.5m] Zones 5-9 ○▶

Downward arching, narrow green, white midrib foliage, large white plumes in late summer.

Miscanthus sinensis 'Strictus'

Porcupine Grass

[ht-1.75m] Zones 6-9 ○▶

Tall growing, similar to Zebra Grass but has an upward habit instead of downward, distinctive yellowish-white horizontal banded leaves, tan coloured plumes in early fall.

Miscanthus sinensis 'Variegatus'

Variegated Silver Grass

[ht-1.8m] Zones 5-9 ○▶

Wide green-white striped leaves, cascading habit, creamy-pink plumes in early fall.

Miscanthus sinensis 'Zebrinus'

Zebra Grass

[ht-2m] Zones 5-9 ○▶

Green leaves, hairy underneath, yellow horizontal bands, red tinted blooms in early fall.

Miscanthus sinensis 'Zwergzebra'

Dwarf Zebra Grass

[ht-1.2m] Zones 5-9 ○▶

Lower growing than the regular Zebra Grass, finer foliage but the same yellow horizontal banded leaves.

Molina caerulea 'Variegata'

Variegated Moor Grass

[ht-60cm] Zones 5-9 ○

A dense, tufted, compact plant with slender upright stems and bright ochre in colour. Leaves are striped dark green and creamy-white. Can be used as a ground cover or edging.

Panicum virgatum 'Cloud Nine'

Cloud Nine Switch Grass

[ht-1.75m] Zones 4-9 ○

A large grass with lovely powder-blue foliage set in a fountain-like form. Produces a large cloud of fluffy, golden flowers in late summer followed by tan seedheads that persist well into winter. Can be grown in full sun to partial shade in almost any type of soil except water logged.

Panicum virgatum 'Dallas Blues'

Dallas Blues Switch Grass

This stunning Switchgrass has blue, three-quarter-inch-wide leaves and billowy pink-colored, seed heads making it stand out in the landscape with its striking physical attributes.

Panicum virgatum 'Heavy Metal'

Switch Grass

Metallic-blue leaves with a very erect upright habit. Delicate seed heads.

Arching clumps of steel-blue leaves, bearing airy heads of tiny green flowers in late summer.

Blue gray leaves turning to ruby red in late summer.

Shenandoah Switch Grass

[ht-1.2m] Zone 4-9 ○

Rich blue-green leaves. Spreads slowly. Airy pinkish panicles in late July. Spacing 120 cm.

Fountain Grass

Clumps of cascading green leaves, flowers are buff coloured.

Dwarf Fountain Grass

Has arching foliage, silvery-brown flower spikes in late August.

One of the more dwarf fountain grasses. Flower spikes are white in late summer and dark green foliage forms a dense mound and turns golden russet in the fall.

Pennisetum alopecuroides **'Red Head'**

Red Head Fountain Grass

[ht-1m] Zones 5-9 ○▶

This new fountain grass has red-hued bottlebrush plumes, a full eight inches long, that emerge in midsummer. The fine-textured blooms extend just above its dark green leaves; foliage forms a rounded, arching habit that brings texture and shape to mixed borders and perennial plantings. When planted in masses, Red Head Fountain Grass creates a dramatic wave of color in the landscape, especially when the wind blows.

Ribbon Grass

[ht-50cm] Zones 6-9 ○

Highly variegated green and white foliage tolerates various soils, withstands drought particularly well.

Dwarf Ribbon Grass

More refined, slender form of the Ribbon Grass, has green and white foliage that is flushed with a pink hue.

Selsleria autumnalis

Autumn Moor Grass

[ht-30cm] Zones 5-9 ○▶

Autumn moor grass is clump-forming ornamental grass, with narrow flower spikes rising above the foliage clump in summer to 18" tall. Flowers give way in autumn to silvery-white inflorescences. Attractive, narrow, yellow-green foliage.

Indian Grass

Native, very drought tolerant once established, erect forming grass, steel blue foliage, yellow fall colour, seed heads are copper-brown colour.

Spartina pectinata 'Aureomarginata'

Variegated Cord Grass/ Marsh Grass

[ht-200cm] Zone 4 ○

Forms a tall clump of arching dark green leaves with narrow yellow edging. Loose creamy-yellow spikes appear in late summer.

Prairie Dropseed

[ht-60cm] Zone 3-9 ○▶

Native, green foliage with light pink blooms, blooms late summer to late fall, bronze fall and winter foliage.

Light feathery foliage, very lush when planted in shade.

This selection of the Northern Lady Fern features vibrant burgundy stems contrasting beautifully with the lacy green fronds.

The perfect companion for Hostas, Coral Bells and other shade-loving perennials.
